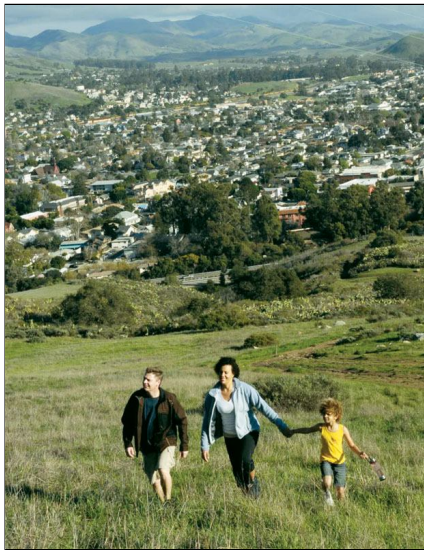

It's 78 degrees and sunny here...perfect for an outdoor adventure!



San Luis Obispo is an undiscovered gem for outdoor recreation enthusiasts.

Miles of off-road trails and back-country roads wind through vineyards and farmland, beckoning cyclists, hikers and runners of all levels.

In the greenbelt that surrounds the city, one of the most popular and challenging hiking spots is the 1,559-foot Bishop Peak, part of a chain of volcanic peaks (dubbed the Seven Sisters) that leads out to the Pacific Ocean at Morro Bay. Within view of Bishop Peak is the 1,292-foot San Luis Mountain, another of the volcanic hills. A trip to each summit rewards hikers and rock-climbers with sweeping views.

The magnificent Santa Lucia mountain range, a pristine coastline and a string of steep volcanic peaks, along with near-perfect year-round weather, make SLO a great spot for hiking, biking, running, golf, kayaking, surfing and rock climbing, to name a few options.
